TICKETING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The sale of tickets for, and attendance at the Rip Curl Pro Bells Beach presented By Bonsoy Event (the "Event") are subject to these General Terms and Conditions as well as any others notified at the time of ticket sales.

By acquiring a ticket for and/or seeking to attend an Event, you agree to these General Terms and Conditions. By purchasing a ticket on behalf of anyone else, you undertake to inform them of these General Terms and Conditions and any other terms and conditions notified at the time of sale.

GENERAL

Daily Event Passes and Festival Passes do not guarantee entry on the day of the event due to capacity limitations at the venue. Capacity limitations are put into place to ensure the continued preservation of the Bells Beach surfing reserve. The Event will only take place on days when surf conditions are suitable, within the designated event waiting period. Entry is subject to availability and may be adjusted in accordance with the event schedule, which can change based on surf conditions. If you leave the event site after entry, re-entry cannot be guaranteed for the remainder of the day.

A call is made each morning by the WSL Commissioners Office on the day's schedule. This generally occurs at 7.30am and is published on www.worldsurfleague.com and/or via the WSL Instagram page.

All Event patrons must follow any instructions provided by staff or contained in all permanent and temporary signage located in the Event and throughout the Venue.

Entry into fenced or signed restricted areas of the Event, including middens and the ocean, is strictly prohibited. Association of Surfing Professionals (ASP) Australia Pty Ltd, t/a WSL Australasia ("Event Organiser") To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Event Organiser accepts no liability for any injury, harm, or fatality resulting from unauthorized access to these areas.

First aid is available on-site, but attendees are responsible for their own health and safety. In a medical emergency, attendees consent to necessary treatment and are responsible for any associated costs, including ambulance fees.

We kindly ask you to please observe all road signs when entering and exiting the event, there is a large amount of local wildlife who live in the area. Please slow down and take care to help protect our local wildlife.

Event Organisers are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal belongings. Attendees should take precautions to secure their valuables.

TICKETS

1. Event Tickets will be available for purchase onsite only, via QR Codes or at ticket box office once the Event Call is announced ON, and it is determined that the venue for surfing will be Bells Beach.
2. Tickets are valid for the day and date of purchase only. **Excluding Festival Passes*
3. Tickets need to be redeemed within 1 Hour of purchase. If they have not been scanned they will expire.
4. The e-ticket must be presented on a Mobile device or as a PDF and exchanged for wristbands at QR Ticket Scanning Line at the main entrance, where venue ushers will secure the wristbands to the spectators' wrists.
5. Once validated, tickets are non-refundable in the event of competition cancellations, and the public will be informed accordingly if competitions are rescheduled the following day due to inclement weather. Refunds for tickets are only processed when the entire event is cancelled for reasons other than force majeure.
6. Children under 12 at the time of entering the Event are admitted to the Event free of charge and must at ALL times be accompanied by a Responsible Adult holding a valid Event ticket. It is the obligation of the Responsible Adult to ensure that they, and all Minors accompanying them comply with the Event Terms and Conditions of Sale and Entry, instructions issued by Event staff. Management may request identification to validate a child is aged 12 and under at the time of entering the event, we will accept the following forms of identification:
 - Copy of birth certificate
 - Copy of current valid passport
7. Concession tickets are available for the following: full-time students, pensioners, Seniors Card holders, children 13 to 16 years. Proof of concession must be produced at the events to obtain the concession price. Concessions are only available where indicated and may be subject to availability. We will accept the following forms of identification:
 - Full-Time Students Cards
 - Pension Cards
 - Health Care Cards
8. Locals will gain entry free of charge if they can display they live at an address within the 3228 Postcode. We will accept the following forms of identification:
 - Victorian driver licence (physical or digital).
 - Victorian learner permit (physical or digital).
 - Victorian proof of age card.
 - Keypass card (physical or digital)
 - Victorian marine licence.
 - Recent Bill or Rates Notice
9. Surfing Victoria Members gain entry free of charge if they provide evidence of a current membership card.

10. Unless otherwise stated, ticket prices include booking fees and GST where applicable. A transaction charge may apply at point of sale.
11. All online ticket sales will be instantly emailed upon ticket purchase.
12. The original purchaser of a ticket may only be entitled to a refund if the Event is called off before the ticket has been validated.
13. Any refund payable for a ticket will be made to the original purchaser of that ticket at the Ticket Sales.
14. Event Organiser has the right to add, withdraw, reschedule and/or vary advertised programs, prices and audience capacity.
15. Program details are correct at time of printing but are subject to change where necessary and without notice.
16. Tickets cannot be replaced if lost, damaged or stolen.
17. Only tickets purchased on site via the Ticket Box or on site QR codes are accepted.
18. The Event presents athletes and productions on the basis of merit and excellence. Any political affiliations or views expressed by athletes, artists or companies participating in, or sponsoring the Event are not necessarily representative of those of the Event Organiser or its staff.
19. Event Organiser is bound by the National Privacy principles under the Privacy Act 1988. Event Organiser holds personal information for the purposes of sending information about the Event and other surfing events.
20. We reserve the right to photograph, record, broadcast and/or telecast the Event and you consent to the use of any image or recording taken of you, and anyone for whom you are responsible, while at the Event, without any reference or compensation to you. We are not obliged to use, broadcast or provide to you any such recording. In providing your consent, you release and discharge the Event Organiser, its staff and its agents from any and all loss, damage, expense or claims that you may suffer or incur by the Event Organiser's use of the photographs and recording.
21. Professional cameras, and video recording of the competition is forbidden at any time, exceptions will be made for media-accredited professionals that require specific credentials.
22. No dogs are allowed on site unless they are a qualified, accredited assistance dog and serving the person they are with. Note: Security may ask you to provide documentation to prove this.
23. Event Organiser reserves the right to remove any spectator from the event site at its sole discretion. Individuals removed from the site are not eligible for a refund.

Prohibited Items include but are not limited to:

- Alcohol - any alcohol bought into the Event Site will be confiscated and will not be returned and the offending patron(s) ejected from the Event Site for the remainder of the Event.
- Glass or breakable containers (jars, bottles, containers, mirrors and perfumes).
- Air horns.
- Weapons or explosives of any kind (including potential missiles).
- Illegal substances or paraphernalia

- Nitrous oxide bulbs and canisters.
- Flares, fireworks, sparklers, explosives or any fire twirling equipment.
- Fires and open flames.
- Vapes & E-Cigs with more than 110mL liquid (please note the venue may have specific smoking regulations and areas)
- Instruments.
- Advanced personal vaporizers (or modified APVs) or liquid refills for E-Cigs.
- Flammable liquids, including deodorant.
- Sound systems.
- Portable laser equipment and pens.
- Paint cans, spray paint or paint pens.
- Drones or other remote control devices.
- Audio or video recording devices (including GoPro and similar).
- Professional photography equipment (e.g. telephoto lenses; any lens over 20cm; any detachable lens; stands or other commercial equipment or anything deemed by Event staff to be professional photography equipment).
- Kites or sky lanterns.
- Toy guns, water guns or slingshots.
- Skateboards, scooters, wagons, carts, rollerblades, roller skates, bicycles, quad-bikes, segways, hoverboards, self-balancing scooters or any personal motorised vehicles.
- Animals (excluding service dogs such as guide dogs and police or emergency service dogs).
- Unauthorised solicitation materials including handbills, flyers, stickers, beach balls, giveaways, samples, or other promotional items.
- Eskies and coolers.
- Cans or metal containers, including aerosols.
- Any other item deemed by Event staff (in their discretion) to be dangerous or offensive or potentially dangerous by Event organisers.

Additional Requirements for March 31

Ticketing and Entry

Entry to the Event site on 31 March is free of charge for all attendees, including both 18+ and under 18 patrons.

1. All attendees are still required to obtain a valid ticket via the official on-site QR code system or ticket box office once the Event is confirmed as proceeding. Tickets must be presented and exchanged for a wristband upon entry.
2. Free ticketing does not guarantee entry. Admission remains subject to venue capacity limits and may be restricted once capacity is reached.

Age and Supervision

All patrons under the age of 18 must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult. The Event Organiser reserves the right to request valid identification to verify age.

Car Parking

Car parking fees apply on 31 March at a rate of \$8 per vehicle.

Conditions of Entry

Conditions of entry, prohibited items, security screening, and all other Event Terms and Conditions remain in full effect on 31 March.
