SHOW N SHINE TERMS & CONDITIONS



1. Entries to close once capacity is reached. A waiting list will be available for those wishing to enter if a position becomes available.
2. Successful entry into the competitions does not automatically allow access into the festival. A Deni Ute Muster adult ticket must be purchased to be able to enter the competitions.
3. A 2025 Deni Ute Muster ticket MUST have been purchased prior/or at the same time as entering the Show n Shine. If you fail to do so your entry will be void.
4. Successful entrants will receive an email and posted letter with competition information.
5. Unsuccessful entrants will be notified via email.
6. All successful entrants must be available to begin competitions at the time specified by Deni Ute Muster organisers.
7. Vehicles must be registered as a utility and must have a tub or tray (removable canopy is allowed).
8. All Utes must be registered and road worthy in compliance with the NSW Roads Traffic Authority.
9. NSW Road Rules apply and will be enforced throughout the event. Drivers should be aware that breathalysers will be operating on site at all times.
10. **Drivers will be breath tested prior to moving their Utes to the show n shine arena on the Friday and Saturday. This will be conducted at 7:30am at the Information Centre (each day) before competitors move their vehicles. A zero-alcohol reading is required for the driver to enter.**
11. Competitors are permitted to enter the Show n Shine Arena from 12:00pm Thursday 2nd of October. The gate will be unlocked from 12:00pm until 6:00pm Thursday otherwise you will be able to enter from 7:30am Friday morning, **after you have completed a zero-alcohol breath test in the operations centre from 7:30am** until 8.00am. Same again Saturday morning.
12. Entry to the Muster site is via the Main Gates with all other patrons.
13. All utes must be parked by 8:00am Friday 3rd October.
14. Voting begins at 8:00am Friday 3rd October and ends at 4:00pm on Friday 3rd October.
15. NO camping is allowed inside the Show n Shine Arena.
16. Utes can be moved between 4:00pm – 4:15pm Friday and Saturday afternoons. After a zero-alcohol breath test is completed (this will be conducted in the show n shine arena). The gate will be open for 15 minutes only. Please return your ute to the Arena Saturday morning before 8:00am **after you have completed a zero alcohol breath test in the operations centre from 7:30am.**
17. The Show n Shine Arena area is licensed so strictly no alcohol to be brought in from the camping areas. Any persons found bringing alcohol into this area will be disqualified from the competition and potentially asked to leave site.
18. As per the festival terms and conditions you cannot bring in any additional tyres or fuel.
19. Drivers assume full responsibility and accept full liability for their own health, well-being, safety, physical actions as the result of partaking in these competitions.

20. Deni Ute Muster event organisers reserve the right to vary the competition times.
21. The entrant must complete and sign every applicable section of this entry form to be able to compete. Any incomplete forms submitted will not be accepted and the entrant will not be allowed to compete.
22. As per the Festival Terms and Conditions Utes on trailers will not be allowed into the Festival. We do not have storage for trailers onsite. If you are transporting your Ute on a trailer, please contact Muster HQ to arrange appropriate storage off site. If you cannot drive your Ute into the festival, it isn't allowed in.
23. If you are caught driving around the camp areas unnecessarily or with passengers in your tray you will be disqualified.
24. All competitors must wear covered shoes when moving vehicles.
25. No deliberate dangerous driving or you will be disqualified. The speed limit is 5km per hour (walking pace) your hazard lights must be on.
26. Maximum speed in the Show n Shine Arena is 5kph (walking speed).
27. Failure to comply with rules and parking instructions given by officials will result in automatic disqualification from the competition.
28. Deni Play on the Plains Festival Limited accepts no responsibility for any damage to vehicles parked within the Show n Shine Arena.
29. Your Show n Shine sticker must be adhered to the driver's side windscreen to gain entry to the Arena.
30. Presentations will take place on Saturday 4th at 10:00am, again your ute cannot be moved until 4:00pm Saturday.
31. Event Officials are not permitted to enter the competitions.
32. Disrespect to event officials will result in automatic disqualification. And affect your ability to apply in 2026.
33. Deni Ute Muster organisers have the right to disqualify any vehicle they deem to be unsafe.
34. Driver of a disqualified vehicle will not receive an entry or ticket refund.
