SEATING OPTIONS

UNRESERVED/CASUAL SEATING

We will have seating (bleacher style) and picnic table settings around the event site with enough for 10-15% of the audience.

It is available on a first come, first served basis.

If you are not eligible for the accessible/disability platform (see below) and really want to attend an event but due to age or health considerations you feel like you can only attend if you can be seated please send an email to office@billions.com.au as follows;

BYO SEATING

RESERVED SEATING

If we do add this option at your event it will be offered to existing ticket holders as a paid upgrade and then any remaining seats will be made available to the general public.
