

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE FESTIVAL

General Festival Conditions

- No pass outs allowed during the event. Re-entry will not be permitted once you exit the venue. Please make sure you bring with you everything needed for the day.
- Prohibited items – For the safety and enjoyment of all guests, the following items are **not permitted** at the event: air horns; silly string; balloons; alcohol; clothing which is suburb or gang related; glass; fireworks, flares or explosives; poles, sticks, banners/flags; weapons/replica weapons or any sharp/dangerous articles.
- Bag checks will be conducted by Security or NSW Police. Sydney Cherry Blossom Festival reserves the right to refuse entry to patrons who do not comply with bag checks.
- Pets are not permitted inside of Auburn Botanic Gardens unless they are a registered assistance animal. We have our own ecosystem and wildlife free in the gardens and introducing a pet can be harmful to wildlife. Qualified Assistance Dogs can accompany their handler into Auburn Botanic Gardens. Permits for assistance animals will need to be sighted by staff and approved permit from:
 - Transport for NSW permit
 - Guide Dogs Australia
 - Vision Australia Seeing Eye Dogs
 - MindDog Australia or
 - Australian Lion Hearing Dogs.
- Respect the natural environment – the Auburn Botanic Gardens is home to free roaming native wildlife and delicate flora ecosystems. Patrons found to be damaging, removing, or interfering with plants, trees, or wildlife will be asked to leave the festival premises.
- Intoxication – patrons displaying signs of intoxication will be refused entry or asked to leave the festival premises.

TICKET CONDITIONS

Cumberland Residents Free Entry

Free Entry for residents of Cumberland City Council Local Government Area. One ticket per resident of Cumberland. Must present valid photo identification including proof of address upon entry to the Festival. If you would like to check whether your address is in Cumberland City, you can check [here](#).

Seniors Card Holder

Concession priced entry for Seniors Card Holders. Must present valid Seniors Card issued by any Australian State or Territory government.

Companion Card Holder

Free entry for support person of NSW Companion Card holder. When a cardholder buys a ticket, their carer or companion is entitled to a second ticket at no charge. Cardholder or support person must present valid Companion Card upon entry to the Festival.

Child (5-16 years old) and Family Pass

Concession priced entry for children aged 5 – 16 years old inclusive. Children will generally not require any proof of age/entitlement for concession pricing. However if a child in your booking looks more mature, please be prepared to provide a proof of age for verification.

Child (5-16 years old) ticket - Unaccompanied Children

Children 12 and under may not attend the festival unaccompanied and must be in the direct supervision of an adult at all times. Children 13 and over may attend the festival unaccompanied; and by purchasing a ticket to the festival you agree that you are attending the festival with the direct approval of your parent or guardian.
