



2026 Deni Ute Muster Driving Competitions Terms and Conditions

Circle Work, Barrel Race and Go to Wo

1. Entries to close once capacity is reached in each competition. A waiting list will be available for those wishing to enter if a position becomes available.
2. Entrants who did not show up in 2025 without notifying staff may not be accepted.
3. Entrants who did not return entry number Ute magnets from the Sports Arena might not be accepted.
4. Successful entry into the competitions does not automatically allow access into the festival. A Deni Ute Muster adult ticket must be purchased to be able to enter the competitions.
5. A 2026 Adult Deni Ute Muster ticket **MUST** be purchased before or at the same time as entering the competition or your entry will be void.
6. The first 65 entrants in each competition will be selected.
7. Successful entrants will receive an email and posted letter with competition information.
8. Unsuccessful entrants will be notified via email.
9. All successful entrants must be available to begin competitions at the time specified by Deni Ute Muster organisers.
10. All Utes must be registered and road worthy to enter the competition.
11. NSW Road Rules apply and will be enforced throughout the event.
12. Drivers will be **breath tested** prior to competing. This will be conducted at 7:30am at the Operations Centre (each day) before competitors move their vehicles. A second breath test will be taken pre competition. A zero alcohol result will be required for a driver to compete.
13. There will be a **mandatory safety briefing** at 8:30am in the holding area of the Sports Arena all competitors must attend.
14. Only those that have entered the competitions have access to the holding area.
15. **As per the festival terms and conditions you cannot bring in any additional tyres or fuel.**
16. Drivers assume full responsibility and accept full liability for their own health, well-being, safety, physical actions as the result of partaking in these competitions.
17. Deni Ute Muster event organisers reserve the right to vary the competition times.
18. The driver must complete and sign **every** applicable section of this entry form to be able to compete. Any incomplete forms submitted **will not** be accepted and driver will not be allowed to compete.
19. Utes must be registered as a utility and must have a tub or a tray (removable canopy allowed).
20. 4WD Utes are not permitted to enter due to safety reasons.
21. As per the Festival Terms and Conditions **Utes on trailers will not be allowed in.** We do not have storage for trailers. If you cannot drive your Ute into the festival, it isn't allowed in.



22. **No passengers are allowed.** This is a driver only event unless required due to impairment such as hearing etc. and supporting documents must be presented if requested.
23. **Only driving competitors are permitted past Gate 3A and in the holding area.**
24. **The driveway entrance to the Sports Arena MUST be clear at all times, unless you are next to compete. NO PERSONS ARE ALLOWED IN THE DRIVEWAY**
25. Whilst waiting or viewing of other competitors, entrants must stand in the allocated "Driving Competitor Viewing Area". Only driving competitors are permitted in this area, no family or friends are allowed in this area.
26. Competitors are not permitted to approach judges or administration volunteers during competitions. Communication must be directed to Sports Arena Co-Ordinator.
27. If you are caught driving around the camp areas unnecessarily or with passengers in your tray you will be disqualified.
28. All competitors must wear covered shoes. No thongs or sandals allowed.
29. Seat belts must be worn and properly adjusted during competition.
30. **Windows must be wound up during the entirety of a run.**
31. No balloons to be released from Utes.
32. No deliberate dangerous driving or you will be disqualified.
33. Failure to comply with rules and parking instructions given by officials will result in automatic disqualification from the competition.
34. Use of bad language or any poor or aggressive behaviour towards event officials will result in immediate disqualification.
35. Burn outs are prohibited.
36. Event officials and Judges are not permitted to enter the competitions.
37. The judge's decision is final.
38. Deni Ute Muster organisers have the right to disqualify any vehicle they deem to be unsafe.
39. Driver of a disqualified vehicle will not receive an entry or ticket refund.
40. There is to be no VICTORY LAP
41. There is to be only the cars competing in the Sports Arena at one time. The exception is when the Top 4 finalist enter the arena for presentations. This must be at site speed limit 10km.
42. Refusal to abide by these terms and conditions will result in future banning from attending the 2027 Deni Ute Muster and subsequent driving competitions.
