

Spooky Scavenger Hunt - Conditions of Entry

By obtaining a ticket and/or participating in the Spooky Scavenger Hunt (the "Experience"), you agree to comply with the following conditions of entry:

- 1. All participants must register to attend the Experience. A valid ticket is required for entry and to access the designated Experience area.
- 2. Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times. Parents and guardians are solely responsible for the supervision, safety, and conduct of children in their care for the duration of the Experience.
- 3. No pushing, shoving, or rough physical contact with other participants will be tolerated.
- 4. Any participant engaging in harassment, disrespectful, unsafe, or disruptive behaviour may be removed from the Experience at the discretion of Experience staff.
- 5. Participants must remain within the designated Experience areas at all times.
- 6. All Experience staff will be identifiable by uniform and/or badge. Participants (and their parents/guardians, where applicable) must follow all lawful and reasonable instructions given by Experience staff.
- 7. No animals are permitted within the designated Experience areas, other than certified assistance animals.
- 8. Strobe lighting, sound effects, and other special effects may be in use. These may affect individuals who are sensitive to such stimuli.
- 9. Scavenger Hunt & Confectionery
 - a) Children may trade collected scavenger hunt items for confectionery at designated stations under the supervision of a parent or guardian.
 - b) All confectionery is provided *as-is* to the parent or guardian of minor children. While manufacturer packaging may include ingredient lists, South Bank Corporation does not guarantee the absence of allergens such as, but not limited to, nuts, dairy, gluten, or soy.
 - c) It is the responsibility of each participant, or the parent/guardian of a child participant, to check the packaging and ensure that any confectionery is safe for their dietary needs.
 - d) The decision as to whether a child may consume any confectionery rests solely with the parent or guardian.
 - e) To the extent permitted by law, South Bank Corporation accepts no liability for any issues arising from the voluntary consumption of confectionery.
- 10. Nothing in these Conditions limits any rights you may have under the Australian Consumer Law or other legislation that cannot be excluded by agreement.
- 11. South Bank Corporation reserves the right to modify, postpone, or cancel the Experience due to weather, safety concerns, or other unforeseen circumstances. Where the law requires, participants may be entitled to a remedy such as rescheduling, credit, or refund.
- 12. Participants with disabilities or special requirements should inform Experience staff upon arrival to ensure appropriate support can be provided.
